# **Contributions & Charges 2025**

**YEAR 1**



Dear Parents and Carers

The Jilbup Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2025. The schedule is broken into three sections and will allow you to calculate and plan for all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

### 1. Voluntary Contributions

The total amount of voluntary contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been set at \$60 per student in Kindergarten to Year 6. This amount complies with the School Education Regulations 2000. Voluntary contributions collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in our curriculum learning areas. These contributions will play an important role in the provision of resources that enable the school to add value to your child's learning experiences.

We offer parents and carers a number of options to assist with paying your contributions.

**Option 1** A single payment of \$60 in Term 4 2024, or at the beginning of Term 1 2025\*

**Option 2** Two instalments of \$30 at the beginning of Term 1 and Term 3 2025\*

**Option 3** Four instalments of \$15 made at the beginning of each term in 2025\*

\* No charge for 3<sup>rd</sup> and subsequent child/ren

**Please note that the contribution of \$60 per child equates to just \$1.50 per week over the school year.**

**We would like to encourage parents and carers to make payments via Direct Deposit or Compass where possible, for this reason payment by EFTPOS is not available. If necessary cash payments will be accepted at the School Office.**

### 2. Charges for Activities and Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, swimming lessons, etc, has been included in the table below. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity.

If the school has been advised in advance that your child will be absent for a paid activity, parents can request a refund from the Administration Office or receive a credit to pay for a future activity. We can also transfer credit to a sibling. Please note that the cost of transport and entry fees are calculated on the number of children attending therefore we still have to pay for your child even if they are absent on the day.

The schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made, ie excursions.
- Specific learning activities available to **selected** students but conditional on a payment being made, ie instrumental music.
- Other activities available to students in a particular year group but conditional on a payment being made, ie graduation function, camp, etc.



### 3. Items for Personal Use

The list and cost of items for personal use will vary between year groups and can be purchased via two options:

#### OPTION 1

- Pay the stationery/consumables charge to the school by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2025.
- All stationery will be supplied to your child on Day 1 of the school year.
- Stationery will be replenished as required over the year.
- Please provide additional items listed under 'Parents to Supply'.
- If you choose this option you agree that all unused items can be redistributed by the school for the following year.

#### OPTION 2

- Advise the school of your intent to purchase your own items by emailing the school - [jilbup.ps@education.wa.edu.au](mailto:jilbup.ps@education.wa.edu.au) by 1 December 2025.
- Please provide ALL listed items from any retailer of your choosing.
- Add your child's name to all items and bring to school on Day 1 of the 2025 school year.
- As required over the year, you will need to replenish items as they run out.
- If you choose this option, all unused items will be returned to your child at the end of the year.

**Please note – as the school has the ability to purchase bulk supplies, the cost of personal items will be significantly reduced if you purchase through Option 1.**
